Footnotes

BELL GOT EVEN was caught in tight early when ON THE BEAT came in, settled between horses three wide, shifted out four wide to launch her bid, opened clear entering the stretch and maintained a safe advantage. SAILORS PASTTIME was caught in tight and was pinched back early, was allowed to settle into stride, circled five wide leaving the turn, finished well but was unable to reach the winner. TEN LIL INDIANS was in tight early, tucked in to save ground, was blocked from the five-sixteenths pole to the quarter pole, altered course sharply between rivals in the upper stretch, kept on well but was left with too much to do. EXECUTIVE SWEET was bumped between horses early when ON THE BEAT came in, shifted out and made a middle move three wide, opened clear leaving the turn but faltered entering the stretch and gave way. BETTY'S CHAMP was bumped between horses early, worked her way forwardly three wide through the turn, offered a mild bid entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. CART MARTIAL was unhurried into stride, swung six wide to make a belated gain but failed to threaten. ON THE BEAT was reluctant to load, veered in leaving the chute stacking up the field, disputed the pace for a half and dropped out. THUNDER CHICKEN was forwardly placed along the inside, was bumped early, stayed on to the turn, but came up empty before going a half and dropped out. SHE'S SALTY TOO was in tight early when ON THE BEAT came in, was hustled along for a contending position four wide, came up empty between horses entering the stretch, was taken in hand and eased to the wire through the final sixteenth but walked off.
