

MUSICAL PRODIGY prompted the pace three wide, wore down KENNY LANE in the final sixteenth and gradually edged clear. KENNY LANE set the pressured pace along the inside, opened clear entering the stretch, kept on well but was unable to resist the winner. NETWORKING settled in hand, circled four wide and was making up ground. DONTBESHY I'LL BUY broke slow, moved into contention between horses, angled in entering the stretch but faltered in the final furlong. MAZUCAMBERA settled saving ground, shifted out to make a mild bid between horses entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. FISCAL POLICY vied for the lead between horses, but was through early and retreated. GRETA'S STAR brushed the gate to get away slowly and was never a factor.
