Footnotes

SAYLER'S CREEK was allowed to settle, advanced between horses through the turn, came five wide, joined the vanguard with a furlong to run, and was fully extended to narrowly prevail. GOLDEN SOUL settled saving ground, got through to make a steady advance, shifted out inside the furlong marker, split rivals inside the sixteenth pole, finished well but just missed. FOR GREATER GLORY vied for the lead along the inside, weakened late following a prolonged drive and was all out to just hold the show. NEW LINE prompted the pace four wide, but flattened between horses during the drive and gave way. MARCHMAN disputed the pace between horses, fought on through a prolonged drive, but grudgingly gave way late. FIGHTERTOWN was allowed to settle, split horses entering the stretch and improved position. LATE NIGHT LU broke in the air to get away well behind his field, made a middle move but came up empty leaving the turn and retreated. BRAZILIAN COURT contended off of the inside to the stretch and tired. SCOUT LEADER was allowed to settle between horses and lacked a response when called upon. TAKIN THE SLOROAD showed little. TIU saved ground to no avail. I DO BELIEVE was through after a half.
