**Footnotes**

KODEMA tracked the pace from early on while four wide, inched to challenge leaving the second turn, then was under mild urging to wear down FLYING FREE in the final stages. FLYING FREE gained the lead near the inside early, edged clear, was engaged nearing the stretch by JOSE GASPAR and the winner, then failed to contain KODEMA in the late going. CANYON DE ORO leaned in at the start bumping JOSE GASPAR, raced three or four wide, improved position late but couldn't menace the top two. JOSE GASPAR, bumped at the start by CANYON DE ORO, went up soon after to press front-running FLYING FREE, offered an earnest bid from between foes nearing the final quarter and weakened soon after. DIA ALEGRE (CHI), near the inside, was finished concluding the second turn. MAIL CALL, three or four wide while outrun early, came out six wide for the drive and never menaced.
