Footnotes

DARBY LANE, never far back and five wide most of the way, closed determinedly under stout left-handed whipping to wear down MS FREDDIE BRIGHT in the last lunge. MS FREDDIE BRIGHT sprinted clear early, moved inside, settled into the final furlong with a clear advantage and had no mishap while unable to last. MARK OF PERFECTION, outrun for a half while racing in behind rivals, came out four or five wide for the drive and offered a mild gain. BANNERSTONE stalked the pace four or five wide into the final furlong and came up empty. SWEET TAFFY, well placed inside, eased out three or four wide in the last eighth but weakened. PROPER PARADISE, outrun to the stretch and racing near the inside throughout, improved position while not a serious threat. BABY GIRL MALIA raced forwardly for five furlongs while four or five wide and weakened. RED RAGE chased the pace four wide and tired. SITA RAM tired early. MUSICAL BEAUTY never was prominent. WHYSOSHY was used early while between foes. WYNN SEEKER six wide always, never was prominent.
