Footnotes

FOR ALWAYS, reserved early and three wide, edged up between rivals three wide on the far turn, continued between horses into the lane, eased out five wide, then drove clear under urging. SPECIAL HERITAGE, five or six wide to the far turn, edged in a bit, moved with the winner while outside that one entering the stretch, was on even terms for the last eighth but couldn't keep pace. PERFORMING DIVA tracked the pace from early on while four wide, inched to the front, then failed to sustain the needed momentum. DYNA'S DESTINY drifted while breaking slowly and bumped the side of the gate, was unhurried, moved between foes nearing the final quarter, was four wide in the late going and finished willingly. SLEW PEG angled in early to force the pace three or four wide, battled on even terms into the final furlong and weakened. STORM ROLLING IN, within easy striking distance and five wide, raced between foes four or five wide on the far turn and failed to rally. LADY DANZA, unhurried early and six wide, continued well off the inside on the backstretch, inched closer as the field tightened approaching the stretch, loomed a factor seven or eight wide for the final furlong and flattened out. DIRECTIVE, well placed between horses three or four wide to the stretch, was empty when straightened for the drive. HEAVENLY OIL moved to the fore early, raced three wide, made the pace for three-quarters and tired. TRICK OF THE SOUTH raced in contention near the inside for six furlongs and tired.
