Footnotes

SUNDRUP (JPN), never far back while following the leaders five wide under light restraint, inched to challenge nearing the final quarter, gained command in the upper stretch, opened a clear advantage, then held sway under hand urging. DELTA PRINCESS, bumped lightly at the start by NOISETTE, settled in hand four wide, was between foes around the far turn, worked her way out eight or nine wide when straightened for the drive and finished well to earn the place. FINERY, rated along from early on while three or four wide, raced within easy striking distance, was five wide between foes for the drive and couldn't muster the needed response. MOVIE STAR (BRZ), in hand while tracking the pace four wide, made a bold bid between horses entering the upper stretch, gained even terms for the lead briefly but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. PAZ CIUDADANA (CHI) settled three wide early, was outrun to the lane, circled horses 10 wide and offered a mild gain. NOISETTE bobbed at the start and leaned in bumping DELTA PRINCESS, raced within easy striking distance although six wide, remained prominent into the upper stretch and failed to fire. KATDOGAWN (GB), sluggish to start, was outrun five wide to the stretch, came out farther on the course and wasn't a serious threat while slightly improving position. STAGE SHY, reluctant to load into the gate which delayed the start several minutes, gained a forward position in behind the leaders early, raced two or three wide into the stretch, angled wider for the drive and flattened out. HUMORISTIC gained the lead near the inside early, made the pace to the far turn and weakened approaching the final quarter. MISS NASHWAN (IRE), outrun near the inside, swung out for the stretch run and never menaced. STUPENDOUS MISS raced within striking distance four wide for six furlongs and failed to offer a further account. LENATAREESE went up early to press front-running HUMORISTIC four wide, stuck a head in front between calls nearing the final quarter and faltered soon after. WHEN STAGE SHY REFUSED TO LOAD, ALL RIVALS EXCEPT NOISETTE WERE UNLOADED. STAGE SHY THEN WAS LOADED FOLLOWED QUICKLY BY THE REMAINDER OF THE FIELD.
