DE PRICE behind the leaders, made a four wide run on the turn, challenged in midstretch and proved best under pressure. AUSPICIOUS RISK outsprinted early, advanced four wide midway through the turn, angled out for the drive and rallied willingly but missed. GUAM TYPHOON outrun early, came five wide into the stretch when rallying but lodged only a mild late bid. LEAVENWORTH within striking distance, moved to the inside late on the turn and lacked a rally. SNAPSHOT set the pace off the inside and tired in the final furlong. LUNAR PASS was no threat. CANON MAN closest to the pace in the three path, stopped.
