GALIENTOS vied early inside rivals, dropped back a bit on the turn, angled out a bit for the drive, came again to challenge once in the stretch and drew clear under mild handling. PATHOKI vied for the lead three wide, took over on the turn, was no match for the winner late but was clearly second best. ZEB with the early pace off the inside, bobbled twice on the turn and tired. THREEFORALL bumped at the start, raced behind the leaders and lacked a late bid. SUN BEAR forced in early, was outrun early, raced seven wide with three furlongs to go and made a mild late gain. HAIL TO SHILOH five wide with three furlongs to go, was no threat. LONESOME STORM bore in early, raced within striking distance and tired. KINGPOST bumped at the start, was outrun.
