Footnotes

RED ALL OVER disputed the pace along the hedge, settled off of NIGHT PARTY entering the stretch, shifted to the outside of that one for the final furlong, came again and gamely edged clear. NIGHT PARTY contested the issue two wide, opened clear entering the stretch, drifted to the inside for the drive and was unable to match strides with the winner. AVENSTOKE lagged well back, wheeled out entering the stretch, finished well and was along for the show. CHALICE broke slow, settled saving ground, moved out and was making up ground between horses late. PREMIER CRU settled between rivals, came four wide but lacked the needed late response. MAPLE LEAF KITTEN was unhurried along the inside, angled out six wide and improved position through the stretch. QUARTERSAWN was forwardly placed along the inside to the stretch and retreated. PLAINVIEW chased the pace three wide to the final furlong and dropped out. READY TO TAUNT was shuffled back at the start, settled in hand, angled out to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. WRONGFUL SUIT bobbled at the start and was never a factor. ARTFUL RUN contended between horses for six furlongs and faded. LION'S REIGN was

through early.
