FOR THREE-YEARS-OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each or by supplementary nomination of \$5,000 each by 12:00 noon (EST) Friday, November 11, 2011. \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights to be announced Saturday, November 12, 2011. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Trophy to winning owner. (If this race is taken off the turf it will be downgraded one grade level for this running only in accordance with American Graded Stakes Committee policy). Closed Wednesday, November 2, 2011 with 30 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One and One Eighth mile.).

Footnotes

BLUES STREET settled in hand, ranged into striking distance four wide, kicked clear entering the stretch and widened. ALLIE'S EVENT broke slow, was unhurried into stride, circled five wide and finished willingly to earn the place. GLEAM OF HOPE was jostled between horses at the start, settled near the tail of the field, moved up through the second turn, offered a mild entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. TAJAAWEED was allowed to settle, tucked in to save ground, angled out entering the stretch but was bottled up between horses through the drive and lost his best chance. BERGERAC broke in bumping GLEAM OF HOPE, was straightened away and attended the pace three wide, but weakened between horses entering the stretch and faded. CHEROKEE LORD was bumped at the start, settled three wide, moved on the second turn, but came up empty between rivals and retreated. ZIMMER opened clear to set the pace, was collared entering the stretch and gave way once headed. PLUTONIUM pulled along the inside, steadied near the three-eighths pole and showed little thereafter.
