**Footnotes**

OUTLIER, within striking distance, came in a bit into the turn, moved back out four wide leaving the turn when rallying and finished with good energy to be up in time. FLEETING HONEY, forwardly placed inside, checked nearing the stretch when challenging inside and in tight, recovered, was angled out for the drive, moved back in for room in midstretch then finished with good determination. WEDNESDAY'S CHILD set the pace just off the inside and held on gamely. LADY GALLAPIAT, within striking distance, moved to challenge four wide approaching the stretch, gained a short lead with a furlong to go and held on gamely. PRINCESS OLIVIA, forwardly placed between rivals, steadied when boxed in around the turn, came out a bit for the drive and finished with good courage. JADEWOOD angled in in the initial furlongs, made a run inside after a half, altered course in deep stretch when blocked then lacked sufficient time to recover. MAMIE MARGARET, within striking distance between rivals, lacked the needed closing bid. TOUCH MY SOUL, closest to the pace, challenged off the inside on the turn but tired in the drive. ROAD TO ROYALTY, outrun early, came four wide out of the turn and could not menace. SHINYCIDEUP drifted in after the start, moved quickly to within striking distance, steadied behind FLEETING HONEY nearing the stretch when that one took up, then tired in the drive. WHAT'S THE FUSS, unhurried early, was fanned six wide into the stretch when rallying and could not menace. DAWN OF THUNDER, within striking distance, steadied on the turn when in tight and attempting to drift out a bit, recovered, advanced five wide into the stretch but could not sustain the bid.
