Footnotes

SILVER COMIC, unhurried into the backstretch while lightly rated, raced five or six wide, continued in that manner with a sweeping run approaching the stretch, came out a bit further on the course for the drive, reached the front leaving the eighth pole, drifted in when clear of rivals and edged away under strong handling. ST CLAIR RIDGE (IRE) maneuvered inside early to stalk the leaders four wide, gained a slight edge while in hand on the backstretch, made the pace into the final furlong but wasn't a match for SILVER COMIC late. CIRCLE OF GOLD (IRE) settled early, moved to the rail on the second turn, made a bold run from the rail approaching the final furlong but flattened out late. THE HAPPY HOPPER, well placed in behind horses early, moved up to force the pace four wide at the far turn, battled on about even terms into the stretch and tired. JAMIE'S COCO POP, sluggish to begin, was angled inside early, saved ground until the stretch, circled foes 10 wide but couldn't threaten while improving position. ATLANTIC DESTINY (IRE), within easy striking distance while between foes, made a run four wide early on the second turn but flattened out when the test came. M AND M MACHINE, outrun until the stretch, passed tired ones. CAPISTRANO DAY, checked soon after the start when in a bit tight, moved inside soon after, quickly reached contention along the inside, remained prominent until approaching the stretch and weakened. WILD HEART DANCING saved ground to no avail. KING'S MATE, a bit fractious in the gate prior to the start, saved ground, angled eight wide at the quarter-mile for the drive but couldn't menace. SCHMOOPY gained a slight edge inside early, lost the advantage to ST CLAIR RIDGE (IRE) on the backstretch and was finished by the far turn. SILVER DEPOSIT went up between rivals early to force the pace, held on until the end of the backstretch and gave way.
