Footnotes

MISS KATE settled inside early, saved ground for six furlongs, eased out four wide to rally, then closed determinedly to wear down GULCH LEGACY. The latter, forwardly placed between rivals three or four wide, took over in the upper stretch, then couldn't contain the winner's surge. EXPLOSIVE GAL moved inside early, saved ground until nearing the stretch, came out to follow the winner five wide, loomed a solid threat and slowly was gaining late. MISS PICKUMS raced three or four wide for six furlongs, came out six wide approaching the stretch, tightened it up on DISTINCT, then gained only slightly in the late stages. CURVE AHEAD ducked in at the start bumping ZETA, alternated for the lead with that one until the stretch and weakened. ZETA, bumped at the start by CURVE AHEAD, contested the pace inside that one until the stretch and tired. FOR HAYMARKET moved out six or seven wide entering the backstretch, continued off the inside approaching the stretch, leaned in tightening it up on DISTINCT, then flattened out in the drive. DISTINCT, well placed from early on while following the leaders five wide, was caught in tight quarters at the quarter-mile ground and bothered by MISS PICKUMS from the inside and FOR HAYMARKET outside, stumbled badly and was eased at the furlong grounds.
