

Footnotes

LEAD STORY, unhurried for a half while rated three wide, eased out five wide to rally on the far turn, came wider nearing the stretch, took over and was kept to her task to remain well clear. REASON TO TALK, in hand while tracking the pace four wide, moved with the winner while inside that one approaching the stretch and couldn't match strides in the drive as second best. SUDDENLY GONE hopped at the start, was reserved soon after and angled inside, was outrun to the stretch, came out five or six wide to make a run into the final furlong but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. DAISYAGO, in contention three or four wide while between foes to the stretch, continued four wide and failed to rally. EMERALDFORAJUDGE settled inside early, was well placed to the lane, continued inside but came up empty. IDEVETER gained the led early, edged in to show the way two or three wide and weakened upon going six furlongs. PERSIMMON RIDGE leaned in nearing the first turn and exchanged bumps with MS ISADORABLE, stalked the pace four or five wide until nearing the stretch and tired. MS ISADORABLE came out entering the first turn exchanging bumps with PERSIMMON RIDGE, raced in contention between foes three or four wide for five furlongs and tired.
