**Footnotes**

WITH DISTINCTION edged in early to contest the pace outside of WANDERIN BOY four wide, inched to a narrow advantage approaching the final quarter, kicked clear, then continued under hand urging. WANDERIN BOY gained a slight edge early, raced near the inside while battling with the winner, dueled with that one to the stretch and couldn't match strides while superior to the rest. EROBERER stalked the dueling leaders from early on while four or five wide and couldn't challenge in the drive while fully extended to maintain his position. DECIBEL, checked in tight between foes at the three-quarter pole, raced five wide, came out seven wide for the drive and lacked a late account. PULPIT'S EDGE, outrun to the stretch, split foes four wide in the late going and improved position. MR. SPOCK, within striking distance four or five wide to the stretch, was empty in the drive. STEAMBOAT SPRINGS, outrun inside to the lane, passed tired foes while remaining near the inside. PYRAMID PERFORMER raced forwardly inside for six furlongs and tired. GLITTERGEM was done early. UNDER CAUTION never was prominent. TUFF MAN DAN raced forwardly inside for five furlongs and faded soon after.
