DYNA SLAM, never far back and in behind horses, moved between foes four wide on the turn, came wider into the stretch and was ridden hard to be along in time. TATTLETALE followed the leaders four wide, swept to a clear advantage in the upper stretch, then failed to contain the winner in the late going. TRUE BLESSING tracked the pace five wide, loomed prominently into the final furlong but came up empty. ACAJOU settled early, lost a bit of position on the turn, moved six or seven wide into the lane and offered a minor gain. ANGEL OF LOVE angled in early to vie for the lead four wide, gained the advantage, held on well until the stretch and weakened. MY COOL CAT, outprinted early and near the inside for a half, came out for the drive and was empty late. WHAT WILL BE had no rally after drifting in at the start. CLEAR CONSCIENCE, forced in at the break, failed to menace. FUSAICHI SPIRIT raced forwardly inside until nearing the stretch and faltered. SKIP THE STORM, sluggish to start and squeezed back a bit, weakened upon going a half. ROSE'S JEWEL never was prominent. GET IT STRAIGHT drifted out at the start and tired early.
