NEXT MAY stalked the pace along the inside, shifted to the outside to launch his bid, shook clear entering the stretch and held safely through the drive. STREET SHOES LARRY settled saving ground while never far back, split horses and angled out leaving the turn, finished willingly and was making up ground. RIDETHEHIGHCOUNTRY angled in to save ground, closed the gap through the turn, steadied leaving the five-sixteenths marker, worked his way out and around RADICAL SWING, dropped back to the rail entering the stretch and came again to earn the show. NAICHE attended the pace along the inside, offered a mild bid from between horses entering the lane but lacked the needed late response. YEMEN was unhurried into stride, advanced three deep through the turn, continued on fairly well from between rivals and improved his position. CONGA KING prompted the pace three wide, assumed a brief lead leaving the turn, but faltered entering the stretch and gave way. BELL BUCKLE was forwardly placed three wide, but drifted out leaving the bend and faded. WANDERLEI settled in the second flight toward the inside, angled out entering the stretch but lacked a response when called upon. EUROSTEEL showed little. COACHTHECHIP steadily retreated. NEW FRONTIER hopped at the start and was always outrun. RADICAL SWING rushed to the lead from between horses, disputed the issue through the turn and stopped.
