**Footnotes**

SOUTHERNENGAGEMENT, never far back, unleashed a sweeping rally five wide nearing the five-sixteenths pole, wrested command entering the stretch, kicked clear and was kept to her task. INDY FUTURE vied for the lead early while three or four wide, battled on the front end to the stretch and wasn't a match for the winner in the drive. KRISTY BEETHOVEN, unhurried early, edged up five or six wide leaving the turn, loomed a solid threat for the last eighth and failed to respond. NEVADA MISS broke awkwardly to trial, was outrun for six furlongs, came out seven wide for the drive and offered a minor gain. SOUL OF THE CAT, well placed between rivals three or four wide to the stretch, eased out six wide for the drive but was empty late. PASTEL COLOUR, unhurried early, raced in behind foes to the lane, eased out five wide but lacked a rally. SOUTHERN BARFLY raced in a striking position near the inside until approaching the stretch and weakened. WEAR forced the pace four wide to the stretch and tired. ISABELLA'S CROWN (JPN) vied for the lead along the inside from early on, battled close up for six furlongs and faltered in the drive.
