Footnotes

OUR TRUMP, never far back, moved steadily after front-running BIG CLASSY GAL four wide on the turn, took over a quarter-mile out, drew clear and was kept to her task. SO HOT, well placed near the inside early, moved out four or five wide nearing the end of the backstretch, continued within easy striking distance the remainder but couldn't challenge OUR TRUMP as second best. BIG CLASSY GAL sprinted clear early, angled in two wide, made the pace to the lane, lost the advantage to the winner and weakened thereafter. WESTWIND BREWING, outrun for five furlongs, made a mild run five wide to reach contention at the furlong grounds but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. HIT THE TRIGGER raced forwardly to the stretch two or three wide and weakened. BARBATINA had no rally. Z COUNTRY was outrun to the stretch and improved position while unable to menace. MISS BLOOM, within striking distance four or five wide to the head of the stretch, failed to offer a closing account. APPEALINGTEMPTING was outrun to the stretch and passed tired

foes. ANNS VISION weakened on the turn while five wide. PRIVY'S JEWEL, reserved early and angled inside, made a run from the rail on the turn to reach easy striking distance but faltered when straightened for the drive. TOOT'S LIL CHIC faded on the turn.
