Footnotes

VOY POR UNO MAS gained a narrow advantage early while dueling four wide outside of THREE TWENTY THREE, went along under careful handling, made the balance of the pace and was hard ridden in the drive to maintain his margin. THREE TWENTY THREE hopped at the start, quickly recovered to contest the pace two or three wide, loomed inside the winner throughout and wasn't good enough. CATMAN RUNNING, within easy striking distance and three or four wide between foes, couldn't produce the needed late response. ELECTRIC CHANT, well off the inside early but never far back, edged in four wide around the turn, had aim through the final furlong and came up empty. CAT SHAKER, within striking distance and three or four wide to the lane, was asked for more when straightened for the drive and failed to respond. RUFF AND READY, eight wide during the early going, edged in four or five wide on the turn but was empty in the stretch run. PASSPORT, three or four wide, failed to threaten.
