Footnotes

DYANI outrun for a mile while unhurried, swung out five wide entering the stretch and closed fast to be up in the final stride. UP IN LIGHTS within striking distance, moved up three wide with three furlongs to go, caught the leaders inside the final furlong but missed while drifting out late. MOLLY MOLLY MOLLY set the early pace in the three path, dropped back a bit after a half, moved out to the middle of the course on the backstretch, angled back in on the third turn, came again to challenge approaching the stretch and held on gamely. SILK ROUTE forwardly placed from the start, angled well out in the course on the backstretch, raced in the four path on the second turn, maintained good position into the final furlong and steadied late when UP IN LIGHTS drifted out. ZAPPARITION within reach from the outset, made a good middle move off the rail, challenged once in the stretch but weakened. COCKTAIL CRUISE unhurried early, raced five wide on the third turn and tired in the drive. BEAUTIFUL SONG was no threat. GREY MIST never menaced. MOURETTE within striking distance four wide, faded. LYRIQUE alternated for the lead inside, held on well to the stretch and faded. KAZOOM was outrun. SOUTHERN SONATA close up early three wide, stopped.
