**Footnotes**

FOREST SECRETS worked her way inward soon after the start to contest the pace outside of front-running MISS LINDA (ARG), headed that one briefly just past the wire for the first time, surrendered the advantage to MISS LINDA (ARG) and eased back under restraint to track the pace three or four wide, took over for good at the quarter-mile ground, was roused sharply with the whip four times on the left side, then, after the rider switched the stick to the right side, was kept to her task. PRINTEMPS (CHI) broke a bit inward, settled three or four wide, moved out five wide on the backstretch, commenced a sweeping run about the five-sixteenths pole, came out eight wide for the drive and was going well at the end. UNBRIDLED ELAINE, a bit sluggish to begin and steadied after being caught in tight quarters when DE BERTIE came out and SPAIN leaned in, raced under light rating three or four wide, came out six wide for the drive and offered a mild gain. MISS LINDA (ARG) gained the lead at the start, raced near the inside, was engaged by the winner midway on the second turn, held on well until the final quarter and weakened. SPAIN leaned in at the start tightening it up on UNBRIDLED ELAINE, settled near the inside under rating within easy striking distance, continued inside when asked for her best a quarter-mile out but was empty in the drive. CARESSING, well placed within easy striking distance while following the leaders four or five wide, was put to a drive three furlongs out, loomed prominently five wide for the final furlong and flattened out. DE BERTIE came out at the start tightening it up on UNBRIDLED ELAINE, saved ground into the backstretch while outrun, came out five wide upon going a half, then moved nine wide into the stretch while unable to menace.
