Footnotes

SEATTLE ASH gained the lead at the start, moved inside, drew clear into the upper stretch and coasted the remainder under mild hand urging. CHAMPAGNE ALLEY, bumped at the start, pressed the winner three or four wide throughout and wasn't good enough. SODA POP TOP maneuvered in early to track the pace four wide, continued forwardly into the final furlong and flattened out. SHEIKH'NNOTSTIRRED leaned in at the start bumping CHAMPAGNE ALLEY, was never far back while in behind horses but failed to rally when straightened for the drive. SURE NUFF, outrun to the stretch and five or six wide, wasn't a serious threat while improving position late seven wide. EMMA'S MYTH moved in four or five wide on the backstretch but never seriously menaced. GLITTER MUSIC broke in the air, quickly recovered to race in contention four or five wide, made an earnest bid into the stretch but flattened out the last eighth. FAIRY DUST failed to rally. TIFFANY'S TIME never was close. ZOLISHKA raced three or four wide in a contending position to

the stretch and tired. KAT CAN DANCE was outrun. SLAUGHTER AND RUN outbroke the rider and unseated him in the second or third stride.
