If more than twelve (12) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to highweights, however two horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single interest. If the race is moved to the main track after the time of closing, a horse may be scratched for any reason at any time up to fifteen (15) minutes prior to post time for the race preceding this race or thereafter with a valid physical reason and approved by the stewards. Footnotes

RISKVERSE, well placed from early on while racing inside under a rating hold, eased outside of front-running BIEN NICOLE entering the upper stretch to be four wide, caught that one a sixteenth out and was hard ridden the remainder. BIEN NICOLE worked her way in early while dueling outside of DYNA DA WYNA, put a head in front just before going a quarter, made the pace three wide, drew clear on the first turn, showed the way into the final furlong and couldn't contain the winner's surge. FIRTH OF LORNE (IRE), well placed inside to the stretch, remained in behind the top two three wide for the drive and failed to offer a late response. PEACEFULLY (IRE) stumbled at the start, quickly recovered, raced within easy striking distance near the inside between rivals, continued prominently four or five wide into the final furlong and failed to respond. DYNA DA WYNA vied for the lead inside of pacesetter BIEN NICOLE during the opening quarter, eased outside that one four wide on the backstretch, loomed a solid threat into the final furlong and flattened out. DELMONICO CAT, never far back, tracked the pace five wide, came wider into the stretch and couldn't produce a closing bid. JANEIAN (NZ) followed the leaders in a striking position four wide from the first turn on, remained a threat into the upper stretch and was empty. SAN DARE, outrun to the stretch while

four wide, angled seven wide into the upper stretch and failed to fire. QUICK TIP lunged in at the start and bumped the side of the gate, settled five or six wide, reached contention nearing the final quarter as the field tightened but was empty when straightened into the stretch. DICK'S CHICK tired after a half. DELICATESSA was outrun. GOLDEN RHYTHM, outrun from the start, raced four wide early, eased out six wide on the backstretch, came 10 abreast into the stretch and never menaced.
