Footnotes

POOLETTA, well placed inside from early on, rallied from the rail into the lane, wrested command and was kept to her task. CUABA, bumped from both sides at the start and steadied when squeezed back to trail, inched up inside on the turn, swung out from between foes six wide entering the upper stretch and was going well at the end. SUPERB RAVI, outsprinted early, raced near the inside, continued near the rail for the stretch run and managed a mild gain. BLANTON FOREST sprinted clear early, raced two or three wide, made the pace to the upper stretch and weakened. OVER THE BORDER, outrun for half, fanned ten wide into the stretch and improved position. DURAJAZZ came out bumping CUABA at the start, raced within striking distance three or four wide into the upper stretch and flattened out. GIRLSJUSWANAHAVFUN, up close between foes three wide for a half, couldn't keep pace. COFFEE SHOP leaned in at the start bumping CUABA and tired on the turn. GENTLY tracked the pace for a half while four or five wide and weakened thereafter. MARGY'S FOREST, never was prominent and raced seven wide on the turn. SWEET ON BERTIE raced in contention five wide for a half and tired.
