Footnotes

DASH OF HUMOR settled near the inside early, was never far back, worked her way out between foes four wide with a quick move nearing the final quarter, wrested command in the upper stretch and was kept to her task. CAT ALERT, well placed and between foes three or four wide, remained a threat into the last eighth but couldn't muster the needed response. MOCHA QUEEN, never far back and between foes four or five wide, couldn't offer the needed late response. GOLDEN LOCKET, maneuvered in behind horses early, made a run five or six wide on the far turn but flattened out in the late going. CONNIE BELLE settled four wide, moved six wide approaching the stretch but flattened out in the late going. ONLY IMAGINE, settled near the inside between foes early, raced five wide on the far turn, fanned wider into the stretch but lacked a serious bid. VICTORY LAP bobbed sharply at the start, was outrun in behind foes four wide, came out ten wide for the drive and never extended herself. ELLA BELLE angled in early to force the pace four wide, stuck a head in front nearing the final quarter but faltered when straightened for the drive. A CLASSIC LIFE, well placed between foes early, raced four wide under rating, was forced to take up in tight at the quarter-mile ground and was finished soon after. FLYING GLITTER sprinted clear early, raced near the inside and tired approaching the stretch.
