Footnotes

CLEAR THINKING, bumped from both sides just after the start, was never far back, split horses three wide in the final furlong and was going away at the finish under urging. APACHE PLUME leaned in at the start bumping CLEAR THINKING, was never far back while four or five wide and wasn't a match in the drive as second best. TIME FLIES moved to the fore two wide, managed a narrow advantage into the final furlong and weakened. PALM PRINCESS appeared unprepared, broke slowly, worked her way inside, angled five wide at the furlong grounds and finished willingly. MATCHLESS MOMENT, bumped at the break by POSITIVE CAT, raced within easy striking distance four or five wide and couldn't muster a closing response. SOMETHINGINtheway went up early to press front-running TIME FLIES three or four wide, loomed menacingly between foes in the final furlong and flattened out. WINTER FOREST came out at the start bumping the winner, raced within striking distance to the stretch five wide and came up empty. CRIMSON WHISPER failed to menace. POSITIVE CAT drifted in at the start bumping MATCHLESS MOMENT, moved inside and was outrun. ST LO raced near the inside and faded approaching the stretch. BAY HEERA bore out after breaking extremely slow and was pulled up soon after.
