SURPRISE SURPRISE stalked the pace three wide, moved up between horses leaving the turn, poked her head in front with a furlong to run and held stubbornly. SWEET GATOR GIRL broke a step slow, advanced between horses, drew even nearing the furlong marker, bumped with GINNY'S GREY repeatedly through the drive, kept on well but just missed. GINNY'S GREY settled in hand, circled five wide through the turn, came to level terms nearing the eighth pole, bumped repeatedly with SWEET GATOR GIRL through the final eighth and gave in late. MOVIN EMPRESS was away alertly, set the pace toward the inside, was headed with a furlong to run and flattened during the drive. CASKET MODEL contended three wide, angled out entering the stretch but lacked a response when called upon. BOW TO NO ONE pulled three wide, bore out entering the turn and failed to threaten. FIRST SQUAD hopped at the start and was never a factor. FLAT OUT NICE rushed up along the inside, but came up empty leaving the turn and dropped out.
