Footnotes

ANNACLONE tracked the pace four wide, drew even nearing the quarter pole, garnered a narrow lead with a furlong to run and held sway. FRANNIE G disputed the pace three wide, fought on through a prolonged drive but grudgingly gave way. BELLAMY'S ROSE was allowed to settle, circled six wide and was along for the show. CTIMENE was bumped at the start, moved up four wide through the turn, but flattened out entering the stretch. C P HATH A WAY was pinched back at the start and unhurried into stride, advanced between horses but was left with too much to do. RED VIXEN settled saving ground, angled out entering the stretch and finished with a belated gain. WISH KEEPER broke outwardly bumping ALL THAT GLIMMERS, was unhurried early and

passed only the tiring ones. SERMONETTES HOPE set the pressured pace along the inside, was headed leaving the turn and gave way readily. FOURTHORNSROSES was unhurried into stride and was never a factor. ALL THAT GLIMMERS was bumped at the start, contended toward the inside for a half and dropped out. HORSCHE was bumped hard at the start, rushed up between horses, but came up empty leaving the turn and dropped out. MS. TURDUCKEN was outrun.
