Footnotes

THEALCHICAL gained a slight edge early while dueling with SHARON SHARON and TAP DANCE, raced under light rating while three or four wide, put away TAP DANCE in the upper stretch, then, while continuing well off the inside, gamely lasted over GILDED BEAUTY. The latter, never far back, came out six wide at the quarter-mile ground to advance, angled inside the winner leaving the eighth pole and was going well at the end only to miss. CURVE AHEAD, outrun early, saved ground, rallied three wide from between rivals in the upper stretch and finished with good energy. TAP DANCE went up early from the outside to force the pace three abreast, loomed menacingly outside the winner entering the stretch but weakened late. GOLF WIDOW, outrun while saving ground for six furlongs, came out six wide for the drive and offered a mild gain. UPSIDE, rated in behind the dueling leaders early, angled out for the drive but flattened out when the test came. SHARON SHARON contested the pace from early on while between horses but faded approaching the stretch. SISTER CRIMSON saved ground but tired.
