Footnotes

RE LYD, four wide early while in hand on the first turn, worked her way to the inside on the backstretch, went along under patient handling, rallied from the rail into the upper stretch, then was under brisk urging to prevail. NAROPA, outrun early, moved inside, saved ground for nearly six furlongs, came out five wide to make a run into the stretch, reached the front a furlong out, then wasn't good enough. COMPEL gained a slim lead near the inside early, showed the way while dueling into the stretch, then grudgingly weakened late. DIANA LOVE settled three or four wide early, eased out five wide when straightened for the drive, loomed a solid threat but came up empty. HUMBLING (IRE), in hand while stalking the pace four or five wide, made a bold run to gain about even terms for the lead nearing the stretch but flattened out when straightened for the drive. DEVIL'S FANTASY, close up between foes to the far turn, weakened gradually. LITTLE LIL, outrun inside for six furlongs, came out six or seven wide for the drive but failed to menace. THE STUBBORN ONE, forwardly placed while five or six wide for a half, weakened thereafter.
