Footnotes

BINTHEBEST, outrun for a half while racing near the inside, came out eight or nine wide for the stretch run and won going away under pressure. DANCING MISSILE sprinted clear early, moved inside, established rapid fractions into the stretch, then wasn't a match for the winner while fully extended. KEATS tracked the leaders four wide into the stretch and was empty the last eighth. MOUNTAIN GENERAL, outsprinted early, moved between foes on the turn, improved position slightly but wasn't a serious threat. MT. BLAKE, in contention while near the inside until the stretch, angled four or five wide for the drive but lacked a closing account. BRAVE, inside while outrun for a half, came out eight wide for the drive and improved position while unable to challenge. WAYBIL came out at the start bumping C. MO, moved up soon after to track the pace four wide and tired in the drive. C. MO, bumped at the start, tired on the turn. JOOPY DOOPY raced in contention inside for a half and tired.
