**Footnotes**

TOP TRIPP was angled inside on the backstretch to force the pace, took over soon after going a quarter, edged clear in the upper stretch while attempting to drift out, then was under extreme pressure to last. RED'S LUCKY LADY, never far back and four wide, angled inside the winner in the upper stretch, had aim from the rail and missed. FEVERINTHEMORNING, bumped at the start by EMOTIONAL RELEASE, was within easy striking distance along the inside on the turn, eased out a bit for the drive, dropped inside the winner for the last eighth but wasn't quite good enough. SEVENTH VEIL, always well placed and five or six wide, couldn't produce the needed late response. SAMANTHA MULDER, in front early and three or four wide, lost the advantage to the winner from the inside, raced forwardly to the lane while outside that one and weakened. SINGASONG, outrun for a half, improved position but wasn't a serious threat. JACOB'S QUEEN, off the inside, was empty in the drive. IT'SCHEMISTRYBABY failed to menace. REDS CHILE weakened nearing the stretch. FRANCHER LAKE never was prominent. ASHFANI raced three or four wide and faded approaching the stretch. EMOTIONAL RELEASE ducked in at the break bumping FEVERINTHEMORNING, was steadied and was through upon going a half.
