Footnotes

TRICK'S PIC, in hand early, settled in behind foes three or four wide, advanced between rivals four wide into the lane and drove clear late. JOSEFINA'S PRIDE, well placed from early on while maneuvering inside, rallied from the rail, loomed boldly in the last eighth but wasn't good enough. COMMERCIALIZE, reserved inside early, continued inside when advancing on the far turn, worked her way out five wide in the final furlong and finished willingly. BEST MOM, outrun for six furlongs, came out ten wide entering the stretch and made a mild gain. MS. LYDONIA tracked the pace four or five wide to the head of the stretch, raced within easy striking distance but flattened out. IDLE QUEST gained the lead near the inside early, went along under careful

handling, showed the way into the final furlong and faltered. BRIDAL PATH popped the gate open prior to the start but did not escape. During the running, BRIDAL PATH settled four or five wide, eased out eight wide for the drive but lacked a closing punch. BEAUGESTE, in hand early while following the pace four or five wide, moved to challenge on the far turn, gained even terms for the lead a quarter-mile out but weakened when straightened for the drive. CARINI (GB) failed to menace. PATRICIA (ARG) weakened on the far turn. SAMANTHA B. raced forwardly between horses until nearing the stretch and tired. WATER GAP tired early.
