PRETTY JENNY went up early to press front-running RUSSIAN GYPSY, took over in the upper stretch, edged clear and continued under mild urging. CHANGE UP, lightly rated along the inside early and always well placed, eased out four wide for the final furlong and couldn't muster the needed response. GENEROSITY, sluggish to begin and outrun early, swung out six wide for the drive and improved position. V. I. P. PRINCESS, four or five wide, was asked for more three furlongs out, continued in contention into the final furlong and never fired. MISS ELSIE, four wide, was steadied alongside RUSSIAN GYPSY when that one broke down leaving the eighth pole and had no rally. CANDY JO, two or three wide, angled a bit wider for the drive and failed to fire. SACRED FEATHER, sluggish to start and outrun two or three wide, was steadied behind RUSSIAN GYPSY when that one broke down leaving the eighth pole and lacked a further account. RUSSIAN GYPSY sprinted to the fore two wide, made the pace into the upper stretch, lost the edge to the winner at the three-sixteenths pole, broke down in her right front soon after the stretch call and was pulled up.
