TEXAS JOSH vied for the lead from the start, took over off the inside on the second turn and drew off under steady urging. PANDERING alternated for the lead outside the winner, raced in the three path on the second turn and held on for the place. BUFFALO SOLDIER outrun early inside, angled out on the backstretch, raced three wide with three furlongs to go and lacked a late bid. VALENTINO FIRST steadied early when in tight, was reserved for a half, raced in the three path on the second turn and could not threaten. SUNDAY MISSILE angled in early tightening up inner rivals, raced close up four wide and faded. RUN MARVIN RUN in close quarters early, raced within striking distance for a half and tired. PARK AND FLY carried in early, failed to menace. HUMOR FRED clipped heels land stumbled early when PARK AND FLY was carried in, was outrun. FINE CHAP prominent early five wide, stopped.
