SERUNI attended the pace in hand, reeled in the leader through the turn, shook clear entering the stretch and widened through the drive. WORLDLY stalked the pace, moved up three wide to make his bid, was unable to match strides with the winner, then was all out to earn the place. NINETY SCHILLINGS settled saving ground under a snug hold, got through entering the stretch and improved position. GRANT JACK was allowed to settle, came four wide to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. BELL BY THE RIDGE was allowed to settle, finished with a belated gain but failed to threaten. STORMY GOING opened clear to set the pace, was collared leaving the turn and gave way readily once headed.
