SALTY STRIKE settled in hand toward the inside, shifted out leaving the turn, split rivals with a furlong to run, forged a narrow lead and held stubbornly. CHEERY tracked the pace three wide, drew even four wide nearing the eighth pole, kept on well but was unable to match strides with the winner. SAM'S BLISS prompted the pace to the outside of MYSTERIOUS CHIMES, took over from that one leaving the turn, fought on through a prolonged drive, but grudgingly gave way late. MYSTERIOUS CHIMES set the pressured pace along the inside, but faltered in the final furlong and faded. ZERMATT broke awkwardly, was unhurried into stride, angled out to make a belated gain but failed to threaten. STARLITE STARBRITE broke slow, was allowed to settle, came four wide but lacked a response when called upon. DISTORTED ALICE was never a factor.
