Footnotes

HEIR JOE was reserved off of the pace under a snug hold, split rivals entering the stretch and quickly drew clear. DR. JAJJO broke slow, was unhurried into stride, swung seven wide entering the stretch and was up in time to earn the place. TEMP was away a step slow, advanced four wide through the turn, split horses nearing the furlong marker and kicked on willingly. SURF CAST disputed the pace three wide, but weakened between horses and gave way. GENTLE MOMENT chased the dueling leaders three wide, but faltered in the final furlong and faded. BAHIM was allowed to settle, came six wide but lacked a response when put to pressure. ASSIPATTLE vied for the lead along the inside through the turn and tired. BREAK OF SILENCE showed little.
