FORYOUREYESONLY, outrun to the far turn while saving ground, remained inside to advance into the stretch, angled out to move four wide from between foes in the final furlong, then was fully extended to capture a three-way photo. WICHITA TIME, checked in tight along the inside approaching the first turn, recovered to contest the pace inside, gained the advantage on the backstretch, settled into the final furlong with a clear lead, then failed to last. SEW AND SEW, close up between foes early, was eased back in behind the dueling leaders, saved ground into the stretch, came out to loomed prominently between foes, then hung. REGRETS ONLY, never far back, made a five wide bid on the second turn but failed to sustain the needed momentum. BROADCAST, outrun for six furlongs, could gain only slightly in the drive. CAT CITY, close up for six furlongs, weakened thereafter. WORTH AVE, sluggish to start, failed to menace. STIRLING BRIDGE was outrun. AUNT EDNA gave way early. YAMIKA was hustled along to vie for the lead early, held on well to the far turn, gave way and was eased.
