RUBY SURPRISE moved out five wide on the backstretch to stalked the leaders in hand, reached the front briefly on the second turn, was displaced just before going six furlongs by GOLDEN TEMPER from the inside, regained the advantage in the upper stretch, then, despite lefthanded whipping, attempted to lug in late while edging clear. GOLDEN TEMPER, in hand early while following the leaders four wide, moved to the fore on the second turn, lost the edge to the winner in the upper stretch and was second best. REFLECT THE MUSIC, sluggish to start, moved up quickly inside, gained a slight advantage when concluding the backstretch, lost it and continued willingly for her position. BATUKA was outrun. LADY CHERYL gained the lead early, made the pace for a half and weakened gradually.
