Footnotes

SILVER BISHOP outrun early and five or six wide for six furlongs, angled out nine or 10 abreast for the drive, caught front-running WERTZ in the final sixteenth and won going away under pressure. WERTZ gained the lead at the start, raced three wide while controlling the pace, settled into the final furlong with a clear advantage, then wasn't a match for SILVER BISHOP. DEVIL TIME, outrun from the start and saving ground for six furlongs, came out three or four wide for the drive and offered a mild gain. GULF STORM, well placed early while forcing the pace between rivals, raced close up into the final furlong and came up empty. FLYING AVIE, within easy striking distance throughout while following the leaders five or six wide, flattened out the last eighth. ASK THE LORD moved up early to force the pace three or four wide, continued forwardly into the upper stretch and weakened. FOUR ON THE FLOOR, nicely placed near the inside until the stretch, weakened thereafter. SEATTLE NIGHT faded on the far turn.
