BELTERRA settled soon after the start, was maneuvered near the inside to race in hand, saved ground while edging closer under patient handling on the second turn, lacked room between the five-sixteenths and quarter-mile markers, angled five wide entering the upper stretch, took over, then won going away under energetic hand urging. TAKE CHARGE LADY, close up inside BORN TO DANCE early, was eased back outside of that one on the first turn, pressed BORN TO DANCE three or four wide, gained a narrow lead approaching the stretch, showed the way until nearing the final furlong and weakened. LOTTA RHYTHM followed the leaders within easy striking distance four or five wide for six furlongs, came out seven wide for the stretch run and couldn't offer a closing account. BORN TO DANCE gained a narrow lead early while dueling outside of TAKE CHARGE LADY, edged clear approaching the backstretch, made the pace for nearly six furlongs and tired. LITERARY LIGHT broke awkwardly and bobbed lightly, recovered to track the pace four wide and faded upon going six furlongs.
