ROSA'S DELAWARE gained the lead early, cleared the field while nicely crossing inside, showed the way under rating three wide, then increased her advantage when kept to her task in the drive. K. C.'S GIFT, outrun for six furlongs while near the inside, swung out seven wide for the drive, couldn't menace the winner but offered a mild gain to dead heat with JOVE'S AUBEE for second. JOVE'S AUBEE tracked the winner from early on while four wide, loomed prominently between foes through the drive but came up empty to finish on even terms with K.C.'S GIFT. TITIA, unhurried early, moved out seven wide approaching the stretch, made a menacing run into the final furlong but failed to continue. EVELITE, well placed while in behind the leaders for a half, tired approaching the stretch. CLASS APPROVAL, never far back and racing inside to the stretch, loomed prominently for the last eighth and came up empty. MISS GOOSEBUMPS, outrun early and racing inside most of the way, lacked a late response while continuing inside. GLORADO chased the winner four wide for six furlongs and weakened in the drive. SUMMERHILL GAL worked her way inside early, reached easy striking distance while between foes four or five wide into the final furlong and flattened out. WHEATHILL (GB) was used early three or four wide, faded on the far turn and was eight wide in the stretch run.
