## Footnotes

BIRDIE SETS SAIL, outrun early, raced in behind rivals, inched up nearing the final quarter, eased out and split foes six wide when straightened for the drive and was hard ridden to prevail. MY OWN STORY, well placed near the inside from early on, had to await room about the three-sixteenths pole, split foes three wide nearing the final furlong and was outfinished. STARS INDY SKIES, never far back, advanced between foes four wide on the far turn, took over in the lane, then couldn't sustain the needed speed. TINK SO, five wide early, settled in behind horses while outrun, came out again to be five wide for the drive and managed a mild gain. BIBLICAL POINT leaned in bumping SPECIAL HERITAGE at the start, came out soon after bumping BELAWOOD, tracked the pace four wide, made a bold run to stick a head in front entering the upper stretch but failed to sustain the needed momentum. KLEOS, reserved early five or six wide, edged in a bit on the final turn, came out again to be six wide for the drive, made a mild bid to reach contention but failed to continue. STORY'S IMAGE settled near the inside early, was unhurried, raced within striking distance to the lane, angled four wide when straightened for the drive and failed to respond. SPECIAL HERITAGE, bumped at the start by BIBLICAL POINT, tracked the pace four or five wide until nearing the final quarter and weakened. BELAWOOD moved to the front inside early, managed a narrow advantage until nearing the stretch and faltered. LAST FEATHER went up to force the pace early while between foes in hand, battled on even terms to the final quarter and gave way readily soon after. MOONLIGHT DREAMER faded after a half.
