Footnotes

OLD MAN BUCK bobbed at the start, was taken in hand to be four wide during the early stages, eased back and maneuvered out seven wide entering the backstretch to secure the best footing, inched to challenge upon going six furlongs, took over, drew clear and was kept to his task. WHY TONTO, never far back and content to follow the pace five or six wide, eased outside the winner to be nine wide for the drive and was fully extended to earn the place. SEASPEAK, well placed from the outset and three or four wide, came out between horses five wide for the drive, loomed prominently for the final furlong and couldn't muster the needed response. CABERNEIGH, well placed between foes four wide early, lost position and fell back last on the far turn, came to the extreme outside to be twelve wide for the final furlong and bested the others. AMAZING RESULTS settled two wide, raced within easy striking distance and couldn't challenge late while improving position. ROLE PLAY went up early to press front-running RICH HERO, raced prominently three or four wide to the stretch and failed to continue. RICH HERO moved to the fore early, was a bit rank for a half, held on well until the stretch and faltered. CHEROKEE TRIANGLE raced forwardly between horses four wide to the stretch and tired.
