WARRIOR POET disputed the pace along the inside, edged clear entering the stretch, fought on tenaciously and proved unyielding through a prolonged drive. AUSTONS SURE CURE stalked the pace three wide, launched his bid four wide, finished well but was unable to reach the winner. SETON HALL contested the pace three wide, weakened slightly between horses following a long drive and grudgingly gave way. VERSAILLES ROAD broke slow, was rank to place along the inside, steadied near the nine-sixteenths pole and again entering the turn, was bottled up through the bend to the furlong marker, altered course to the outside and was making up ground once clear. SPARTAN KING was hustled along five wide to the final furlong and faded. FIJI STAR (ARG) was hustled along between horses, bumped repeatedly with LOOKS PURRRFECT from the nine-sixteenths pole to the seven-sixteenths pole, came up empty entering the stretch and gave way. LOOKS PURRRFECT contended between horses, bumped repeatedly with FIJI STAR (ARG) from the nine-sixteenths pole to the seven-sixteenths pole, faltered after six furlongs and retreated.
