WHERE'S THE BEEF opened clear to dictate terms, remained unchallenged and drew away to score as the rider pleased. INDIAN EDDIE lunged at the start to get away slowly, pulled to contention between horses, shifted out four wide on the second turn, and kept on well to earn the place. SUNDAY FUNDAY chased WHERE'S THE BEEF to no avail, weakened during the drive and had just enough to hold the show. WOLFCAMP was allowed to settle, commenced his bid four wide, steadied between horses near the three-sixteenths pole, swung to the outside and kept on well once clear. NEON TAN was allowed to settle, made a mild rally four wide through the second turn but flattened in the final furlong. MCKAYLA'S WISH was forwardly placed along the inside for six furlongs and faded. LUCKIE CHUCKIE contended between horses to the second turn and dropped out. MACH TWELVE was close up four wide to the five-sixteenths pole and stopped. TOCCATINA was outrun.
