Footnotes

GULFPORT was close up three wide, drew even after a half, edged clear leaving the turn, turned back the bid of MIDAS DANCER inside the furlong marker and gamely drew away. MIDAS DANCER stalked the pace four wide, loomed large entering the stretch, drew to near level terms with the winner with a furlong to run, but was unable to match strides late. TWIN ENGINE was allowed to settle, made a steady advance circling six wide and was just up to earn the show. FIVE IRON took over after half, disputed the issue through the turn, was unable to match strides with the winner entering the stretch, weakened further and faded. FAVORITE UNCLE stalked the pace off of the inside, bid between horses entering the stretch but flattened during the drive. REI was allowed to settle, angled in to save ground, shifted out and improved position between rivals. SYMPHONY FORTY ONE made a middle move between horses to make a mild bid but faltered leaving the turn. SEAL BEACH was unhurried into stride, finished with a belated gain but failed to threaten. HE'S SO FINE was allowed to settle, came five wide but lacked a response when called upon. WILD BILLUM was slow into stride and was never a factor. STRONG RESPONSE flashed speed along the inside, was headed after a half and gave way readily. ARMY HERO showed little.
